AC/DC reschedules postponed show for April 13

Louisville, KY (December 1, 2009) – AC/DC has rescheduled its postponed *Black Ice Tour* show for Tuesday, April 13 at 8 p.m. in the Kentucky Exposition Center's Freedom Hall. Tickets are officially back on sale Tuesday, Dec. 1 at 7 a.m. Ticket prices are \$91.50 and \$47, reserved seating. All previously purchased tickets for the postponed Oct. 6 show will be honored for the April 13 performance. There is a ticket limit of four tickets per person in the first 20 rows.
