American Carnage Tour: Megadeth and Slayer's
February 2 Show Canceled

Louisville, KY (January 25, 2010) – The American Carnage Tour featuring Megadeth and Slayer with special guest Testament scheduled for Tuesday, Feb. 2 in the Kentucky Exposition Center's Broadbent Arena is canceled.

According to Slayer's web site, Tom Araya, bassist and vocalist for the group, will undergo back surgery at the end of January.

"Tom gave various medical treatments more than a fair shot," said Rick Sales, Slayer's manager. "But they just haven't handled the problem, so he's biting the bullet and is scheduled for back surgery at the end of this month."
