Fair Board Hiring 400 Part-time Positions for Venue Services Department

LOUISVILLE, KY (June 10, 2010) – The Kentucky State Fair Board will add more than 400 part-time staff to its Venue Services Department to assist patrons during events at the Fair Board’s three facilities – the Kentucky Exposition Center, the Kentucky International Convention Center and the new KFC Yum! Center.

“It’s important that we expand the Fair Board’s Venue Services Department,” said Harold Workman, president and CEO of the Kentucky State Fair Board. “As we grow our facility space with the KFC Yum! Center, we must add knowledgeable employees in the areas involving customer service.”

Those interested in applying for the available openings need to come prepared to complete an on-site interview during one of the four Venue Services Staff Recruiting Fair sessions that are conducted on a walk-in basis. The sessions take place Wednesday, June 16 through Saturday, June 19 in South Wing C, Rooms 105-108 at the Kentucky Exposition Center. Recruiting Fair sessions are scheduled as follows:

Wednesday, June 16	11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Thursday, June 17	3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Friday, June 18	1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Saturday, June 19	1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The Fair Board is seeking individuals to serve as ticket sellers, ticket takers, ushers, concierges, elevator operators and t-shirt security guards. The Venue Services staff meets, greets and assists patrons during family shows, concerts and University of Louisville basketball games at the Kentucky Exposition Center, including Freedom Hall and Broadbent Arena, the Kentucky International Convention Center and the KFC Yum! Center, scheduled to open in October. All applicants must be 18-years-old to apply.
